Kerrigan & Mock v. Connecticut Dept. of Public Health



Kerrigan & Mock et al v. Connecticut Department of Public Health seeks to end Connecticut's exclusion of

lesbian and gay couples from marriage rights.

The plaintiff couples, who have been in committed relationships for between 10 and 28 years, many of them raising children, contend that only marriage will provide them with the protections and benefits they need to live securely as a family. Five of the seven couples have young children; some have faced health issues and worry about being denied access to one other in times of crisis. While all the couples are concerned about receiving the full range of protections that only flow through marriage, many also believe that only marriage will convey the depth and commitment of their relationships to their families and the



world at large.

GLAD is representing teh plaintiffs in cooperation with Maureen Murphy of Murphy, Murphy, Nugent in New Haven, Kenneth J. Bartschi of Horton, Shields & Knox in Hartford, and the <u>Connecticut Civil Liberties Union</u>. The defendants are the Department of Public Health (DPH), which supervises the registration of all marriages, and Dorothy C. Bean, the town registrar of vital statistics in Madison, who denied plaintiffs marriage licenses.

Cote-Whitacre v. Dep't of Public Health



In Goodridge et al v. Department of Public Health, the state's highest court ruled that denying marriage to

gay and lesbian couples violates the equality and liberty guarantees of the state Constitution. Because the government is continuing to deny certain eligible same-sex couples the right to marry, GLAD has gone back to court.

Cote-Whitacre et al v. Department of Public Health seeks to end yet another version of marriage discrimination



against same-sex couples by the Executive branch of the Massachusetts government: the denial of marriage to gay and lesbian non-residents.

GLAD's *Cote -Whitacre* suit was filed in conjunction with *Johnstone et al v. Reilly*, a suit by 13 city and town clerks challenging Massachusetts' denial of marriage licenses to non-residents. These cases have been consolidated.

Goodridge: Equal Marriage in Massachusetts



On November 18, 2003 the MA Supreme Judicial Court ruled in GLAD's historic case, *Goodridge*
